Best Kept Allotment 2024

Yes, it's that time of year again! The annual judging for Best Kept Competition will be taking place in June. A small panel of committee members from each site will judge all plots and select the best 10 plots from each site. These selected plots will then be put forward for final judging by independent judges in mid-July who will determine the best plot on each site. Each site winner will receive a prize of £25 voucher to be spent at the Members' Shop. Of these two, the plot gaining the most points will be declared the overall winner and the tenant awarded the Basil Byrant Cup.

In addition, a separate independently judged competition will select two Best Newcomers. One from North Road and one from Clothall Road. These awards are for new tenants that started from 1 May 2023-30 April 2024. Each Best Newcomer will receive a prize of £10 voucher to be spent at the Members' Shop. The winner of the Clothall Road site will be awarded the Frank Conway Cup and the winner of the North Road site will be awarded the John Gray Cup.

Non-cultivation Inspections

It's that time of year again when we need to conduct checks on all plots, in accordance with the cultivation requirements that are set out in every plot-holder's Tenancy Agreement.

The process is designed to be supportive. i.e. to encourage everyone to actively cultivate their plots where possible. With this in mind, this year BALGA is introducing a 'cultivation improvement plan' for those who may be struggling to maintain their plots and who would welcome specific advice and guidance in order to meet the requirements within the Tenancy Agreement.

As previously, BALGA will also take fully into account any genuine extenuating and/or exceptional circumstances - please note that it is helpful for tenants to inform us if this is the case. Please let any member of the committee know as soon as possible if there are factors influencing your ability to maintain your plot.

The criteria have been simplified for 2024 - there is one criterion as follows:

At least 75% of the plot should be in a good state of preparation and/or cultivation and the plot should be reasonably free from weeds and noxious plants

Checks will commence in late May and where appropriate, a written gentle reminder will be issued. Further checks will take place in late June, and again at the end of July. On rare occasions where there is no improvement and no mitigating circumstances, BALGA may unfortunately need to terminate the tenancy, in line with the tenancy agreement requirements. If you are on site when checks are being conducted, please come and chat with the team! **BALGA Committee**

Working Parties

A big thank you to the 19 members who joined one or more of three recent work parties on North Road site. The task was to clear and sort the vast amount of worthless items and structures that had been accumulated by a tenant on two half plots for which tenancies had been terminated by Balga under its Non Cultivation Policy. Large amounts of poor condition wood were burnt and the remainder sorted into a huge pile of general waste and a smaller one of scrap metal. The waste was removed by a licensed contractor to be legally disposed of with the metal taken separately. This cost Balga £1656 incl VAT - money that could otherwise have been spent for the benefit of members. Without the commendable efforts of those volunteering jointly giving over 50 hours of their time, and the ability to safely burn the wood on site, this cost would have

been considerably greater. A clearance of any rubbish dumped on either site is obviously a costly process if Balga has to remove it. Mick Camp (Chairman)
