Becoming a Co-Operative

As you will know from previous newsletters, your BALGA committee have been working hard to change BALGA from an unincorporated association to a cooperative (co-op). The co-op consultations papers will be coming to your inbox/post box very soon and replies will need to be returned by November 25th.

The National Allotment Society (NAS) strongly recommends this cooperative model, which will enable us to manage and protect BALGA more effectively for the long term.

You will receive the following documents via email or hand delivered for those not on email:

- 1. Proposed Model Rules
- 2. Revised Tenancy Agreement
- 3. Members Agreement.
- 4. Committee Procedure

How Will These Changes Affect You?

- Membership Share: Every member will hold a single, non-withdrawable, non-transferrable share in BALGA at a nominal cost of £1. No dividends will be payable, and BALGA will continue to hold its £1 share in the NAS.
- Membership Fees: With fees increasing to £7 for 2024/2025, we'll use the additional £1 to cover the cost of each current member's share this year. New members will pay for their share upon joining in subsequent years.
- **Membership Agreement**: Each member must agree in writing to abide by the new Rules.

North Road Expansion

Starting in November, work will commence to clear and prepare the area pictured on the right for future allotment use. The project, conducted under a license granted by North Herts Council, will involve clearing overgrown vegetation, installing fencing, and restoring the land to a suitable condition for cultivation. The entire process is anticipated to take several weeks. During this period, various machinery will be in operation on-site. For safety, please keep dogs, children, and other visitors under close supervision while work is underway.
